

COOKIES POLICY

INTRODUCTION

This Cookies Policy (“**Policy**”) is established by EduIndustry Sp. z o.o. (“**EduIndustry**“, “**Repetry**“, “**Company**“, “**we**“, “**us**” or “**our**”) to inform the users of the processing we carry out in relation to your personal data or the personal data you provide us with through the use of cookies.

We use cookies on our platform [<https://repetry.com/>], (“**Platform**”) for the following purposes:

- to recognize your device and save the actions you have previously made;
- to analyse the users’ usage of the Platform to improve our services;
- to prevent fraud;
- to ensure the functionality of the Platform;
- for marketing purposes as provided for in the description of the cookies;
- for other purposes described in this Policy.

COOKIES OVERVIEW

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your browser or device by websites, apps, online media, and advertisements that are used to remember your preferences, browser, or device settings which are relevant during and across the Platform use and visits. The information may not always identify you, but it can give you a more personalised web experience.

Cookies by provider

There are two types of cookies divided in accordance with the category of provider, namely:

- **First-party cookies:** cookies placed on the Platform by the host of the domain the user is visiting which we have put in.
- **Third-party cookies:** cookies that are placed on the Platform by domains other than the one the user is visiting. As a variety of features necessary to ensure the personalised and convenient user experience may not be delivered by the Company itself, third-party cookies are used.

We use both first-party and third-party cookies.

Cookies by the period of expiry

The cookies also vary depending on the period of retention, namely:

- **Session cookies:** these are the temporary cookies, which are deleted when you leave the Platform.
- **Persistent cookies:** these cookies stay in one of your browser's subfolders until you delete them manually or your browser deletes them based on the duration period in the persistent cookie's file.

We use both the session and persistent cookies.

YOUR CHOICES

You have the right to choose whether to accept the particular cookies. However, cookies are an essential part of how our Platform works. Please be aware that if you choose to block or delete particular cookies, some features of our Platform may not function well or may become unavailable.

Most web browsers are, by default, set to accept cookies. However, you can still set your browser to block or delete cookies. To modify the settings of your browser, follow the instructions included in the following links:

Please bear in mind that this policy DOES NOT cover the cookies provided by third parties when you follow the links to any website other than ours.

TYPES OF COOKIES, PURPOSES AND RETENTION

We use four main types of cookies, including those placed by the third-party services that appear on our Platform:

- **Necessary:** enable users to use the Platform by providing basic functions, e.g., login functions, ensuring security. The Platform cannot function properly without these cookies;
- **Analytics:** these cookies collect information about how users interact with our Platform (e.g. page visits and page load speed). These cookies are sometimes placed by third-party providers of web traffic analysis services;
- **Marketing:** these cookies are used to track the website visitor's interest in a particular product, and deliver a targeted advertisement to users. These cookies are placed by us and selected third parties and enable adverts to be presented to you on third-party websites;
- **Preferential:** enable our Platform to remember choices you make (such as language preferences) and recognize you when you return.

LEGAL GROUNDS

We use cookies under Article 6 of the GDPR based on the following grounds:

- a) consent of the user;
- b) legitimate interest of the Company.

We collect the necessary and preferential cookies on the basis of our legitimate interest, namely:

- to implement a login function on the Platform;

- to detect if the website visitor has accepted the marketing category in the cookie banner;
- for load balancing (to optimize user experience);
- to preserve user session state across page requests;
- to check if user's browser supports cookies;
- to prevent cross-site request forgery (for security purposes).

Necessary cookies are always active.

Preferential cookies are off unless, for example, the user chooses to manage their preferences in another way. In this case, the preferential cookies turn on automatically to ensure the user's request.

Other cookies, namely the analytics and marketing cookies, are used only on the basis of the user's consent.

The following table sets out the different categories of cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them.

Necessary cookies:

Our Website cannot function properly without these cookies. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information. Some of the cookies are session cookies and will be deleted as you exit the Website, others could be stored for up to 2 years after your last visit to our Website before they are automatically deleted.

Analytics cookies

Cookies help us learn how well our Website and plugins perform in different locations. We also use cookies to understand how users interact with the Services, improve the content, and the Services and implement features that improve the user's experience. Those cookies could be stored for up to 2 years after your last visit to our Website before they are automatically deleted. Please note that some of the cookies are persistent cookies that will not be deleted automatically and therefore should be deleted manually.

Marketing cookies:

Repetry may use cookies in order to provide you with more relevant advertising when you use the Services. Cookies will enable us to know more about your prior visits to Repetry and your activity within Repetry, including the date and time of visits, time spent on the Website as well as the pages viewed and websites previously visited. Some of the cookies are session cookies and will be deleted as you exit the Website, others could be stored for up to 3 years after your last visit to our Website before they are automatically deleted. Please note that some of the cookies are persistent cookies that will not be deleted automatically and therefore should be deleted manually.

Preferential cookies:

Cookies that enhance your experience with our Services and allow us to maintain your user's preferences. Some of the cookies are session cookies and will be deleted as you exit the Website, others are persistent cookies that will not be deleted automatically and therefore should be deleted manually.
